Dr. Jan Cedric Hansen is Director of the British strategic consultant firm StratAdviser Ltd since 2008 and he also serves as Chief Medical Officer of a French Public Nursing Home founded in 1267. Jan Cedric is a member of the strategic steering board of the Regional Public Hospital Trust in Normandy and reviewer for the Disaster Medicine and Public Health Preparedness Journal. He teaches global health issues of Europe-Africa international relations at Senghor University and at Szeged University.

Dr. Tracey McNamara, DVM, DACVP is a Veterinary pathologist and a Professor of Pathology at Western University of Health Sciences College of Veterinary Medicine in Pomona, CA. Tracey played the catalyst's role in identifying West Nile Virus (WNV) in the summer of 1999, working as the lead pathologist at the Bronx Zoo amidst a rising number of dead crows near zoo grounds.

John Quinn, MD, MPH works at Charles University in Prague Institute of Hygiene and Epidemiology, First Faculty of Medicine, Prague Center for Global Health. John works on his postdoctoral research in Hygiene and Epidemiology and teaches hygiene and epidemiology courses related to emergency medicine, war, water and global health. He designed, runs and organizes the "News in Medicine – Journal Club" course and serves as official reviewer for two impacted public health and clinically oriented journals.

OUR TOPIC

The world struggles with the COVID-19 pandemic. Disease warning, proper communication, countering disinformation and the appropriate risk assessment that particularly takes the cross-sectoral interdependencies (between the economic sector, education, health sector, media etc.) into account were not activated in time or are still not available at all. Especially the role of the security sector as such but most importantly in fragile and conflict-affected states is underestimated and underutilized. Stabilized security and a purposeful utilization of the security sector resources will be a key element in these settings to ensure community resilience.
